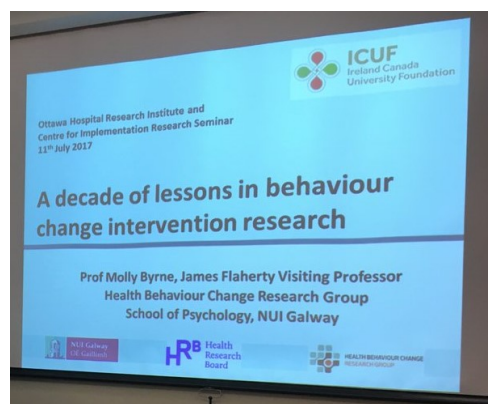

[Dr Molly Byrne](#) is a Health Research Board Research Leader and Director of the [Health Behaviour Change Research Group](#) at the National University of Ireland, Galway. In this group, Molly and her team aim to lead the health behavioural research agenda, by identifying and pursuing research priorities which impact health. They apply behavioural science to the development and evaluation of theory-based complex interventions to promote behaviour change within health services and public health. Much of Molly's research has focused on management of chronic illness (primarily diabetes and cardiovascular disease) and all her research is done within multidisciplinary teams and using participatory methods for impact.
